- Day Camp Program – Bible School for Children (K-6)

- Labyrinth available for those wanting to take a spiritual walk.
- Approved Agency with the Randolph County Schools--allowing students to get volunteer hours
- Approved Disaster Shelter

Christmas Store: New toys, underwear, gloves, socks

Food Pantry: Canned vegetables, sweet peas, sauerkraut, green beans, tomatoes, corn, carrots, applesauce, fruit cocktail, flour, dry beans, cereal, canned pork-n-beans, macaroni, peanut butter
