DRESS CODE

- Shorts no higher than finger tips
- All swimsuits must be 1 piece
- Clothing shall be free from offensive printing
- If wearing tank top, they must be at least one inch covering each shoulder
- No tank tops allowed to be worn when dining. Must wear sleeved t-shirt or blouse when in dining hall
- Shoes and shirts are required at all times (unless swimming). Flip Flops may be worn, but not during meals (dining hall), hiking, campfire or vespers.
- Parents & campers are to realize this is a church camp, campers are expected to act accordingly. If there is a problem the parent will be called to pick up camper.

Camp will conclude at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, June 28th. Campers can be picked up from 2:00 – 4:00 p.m., please do not arrive earlier than 2:00 and no later than 4:00 p.m. If you cannot pick up your child by 4:00 p.m. please notify the camp director to make other arrangements.

While phone calls and visits are permitted, they are discouraged. If you come to camp you must register at the camp office (Activities Lodge). If you call camp simply to talk with your child, your call will be handled by the camp director as to deem the importance of the call.
