### **District Superintendent's Report to 2021 District Conference**

WOW...what a year this has been! For many of us, COVID-19 has really turned the way we do things upside-down. But as I mentioned in our charge conferences, so far, the novel coronavirus has only been an inconvenience for me. There are many who recognize that there are families who are grieving the losses of their loved ones. As of the date I'm writing this report, there are 8,238 Maryland families and 2,737 West Virginia families that have had to say goodbye to someone they love. Across the world, there have been 2,919,033 deaths recorded that are in direct relation to this pandemic. My heart aches for those that are grieving during this time. As the church, we have been given opportunities to respond to those who are hurting. We have been given opportunities to continue the ministry of comfort and care, even when it has taken on a new form than what we are accustomed to.

As laity and clergy in the Potomac Highlands District, over the last year we have been able to connect with individuals that we have never known before. I can't count the number of people who have shared with me that their on-line Worship services have reached far and wide! I'm hearing from you that many of our shutins are feeling more connected to the church than they've felt in a long time. Many churches are continuing to meet, or exceed, their budget as members are going the extra mile. In several cases, the giving of tithes and offerings are up! These are all powerful testimonies to the resilience of God's people. However, what I'm most excited about is the fact that Worship never stopped! God has continued to be the focus of all that we say and do. Some churches have been able to safely gather through the practice of physical distancing, mask wearing and sanitation stations. Many have worshipped outside in picnic shelters or side yards. Several have purchased FM transmitters and invited people to attend church in the safety of their own cars (Jumper cables have only been needed on a few occasions... (a)). Many of you have embraced the gift of technology and held Zoom Worship services and church committee meetings. You have undertaken the concept of using Facebook Live and YouTube to share weekly Worship services. Some of you have held Virtual Hymn Sings, Virtual Youth Meetings and Virtual Vacation Bible Schools. Some congregations have created "hot spots" for area youth to do their schoolwork. You have volunteered at COVID testing and vaccination clinics. You have continued to feed those who are hungry through your food pantries and partnerships with food banks. And there are many other ministries that you continue despite the struggles we have experienced. You are resilient!!!

On the district and conference levels, we have had to change the way we do things as well. Many of our meetings have been held virtually. Conferences have been held via zoom, outdoors, or with physical distancing/masks in place. Clergy Interviews have been held outside and on-line. The "Polar Plunge" turned into a "Virtual Hot Wheels Race" and other wonderful challenges listed on the district website. We continue to support the Celebration Of Missions Event through these ministries. In addition, we have continued to communicate with the great people from Rise Against Hunger. We have supported their ministry financially but hope to hold "packing events" sometime in the near future. Still yet, it's a joy to see the Burlington United Methodist Family Services rebuilding after the 2020 fire. We hope to continue our support of providing volunteers at the next Apple Harvest Festival.

Like many of you, I look forward to the day when we can gather again safely. However, I never anticipate things going back to "normal"...and to be truthful, I hope that it doesn't. We have learned too much on how to connect with people we had been unable to reach. We have learned valuable information on how to do ministry when our typical avenues have had to change. I once heard someone say that "You can't teach an old dog new tricks." However, if there is a silver lining in this pandemic, I believe that it is possible to learn new things while we serve God and reach people for Christ. Thank you for all that you do to build the Kingdom of God! God Bless!

The trip is long and tiring, but for those who left what they know and committed and scarified to travel thousands of miles to a foreign place, know without a doubt, it was all worth it. Once you peel yourself out of the van and step onto the dry red dusty soil you know you are to be here at this time. The angelic voices of lined up students singing a beautiful song of welcome penetrates your heart. We are now at Living Hope High School, Bungoma Kenya.

Many from the Potomac Highlands and beyond have made that journey. It was a dream of a woman, Marilyn Uhl, who left everything and listened to God's voice. She was called to go and teach and feed the children of Kenya. Her vision spread and touched many others. YOU! Are the others whose hearts were moved to make this dream a reality. The WV Conference, Churches and Individuals have helped to grow this small school that started in an old run down building with a few students into a beautiful complex with dorms, clinic, classrooms, gardens and much more. A place where students, 86 of them at the moment, get 3 meals a day, a bed to sleep in and most of all love and HOPE, and a wonderful EDUCATION!

### Here is the latest update from Marilyn and the school:

Right now including the current form 4s we have 86 students, 20 form 4s. The form 1s 2s and 3s are on lockdown. But they will return on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. Living hope High School graduated our first class in 2013. We had 20 kids in each class; so far we have graduated 160. On average 10 out of 20 students go on to higher education, college, university and technical schools. Right now we have 65 kids in college and 35 have graduated from college. We have teachers, Ministers, a dentist, several doctors in medical school getting ready to graduate; we have chefs, zoologist, several Engineers and many more getting ready to graduate. We have 15 form ones not sponsored from last year and the new form ones are supposed to come in July. Some of our current projects are raising as much money as we can and finding sponsors for the old form ones. We have got donations, welcome kits, mattresses, and bibles so far. We need blankets for all the new kids, \$200 for 20 blankets, \$120 for 20 pillows and at least 20 pairs of uniform that is \$20. The more donations we get, the lower the price for tuition for form ones. We have all our fields planted and we are trying to raise as much as food as we can to keep the cost low. Let's hope for good growing season. Our buckets of hope project are in the negative. The hard times have just begun, many people are hungry. It costs us \$30 for each bucket and contents. We can't give out any more until we get some donations.

#### Blessings;

- 1. We got a wonderful gift from the New York Tully Rotary Club for new textbooks. We have them all covered with plastic so they will last and we will continue to distribute them to students when they come back in two weeks. This is the first time in 12 years that everybody has a book for every subject.
- 2. We lost one of our teachers and have found a new replacement, He will start on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. He will be teaching Geography and Math.
- 3. Riverton United Methodist Church has donated new mattresses for the form ones.
- 4.Donna Coblintz and her family have donated 20 welcome kits, personal items and have paid for the shipping.
- 5.An Individual donated funds for the 20 new bibles and other money came in for graduation.

- 6.Our new replacement cow got bred in June and had a new little bull calf last week. He was so big and we called him Big Boy. The Nurse wants to buy him as soon and he weans.
- 7. The Government has said that the schools will open as scheduled on May 3<sup>rd</sup>.

### Needs;

We have a nice Computer Lab with & computers and no printer. We need help with putting in Wi-Fi system instead of buying data bundles. Right now we spent \$60-\$80 a month and the Wi-Fi will be much more economical. All of the Form 4s has had a computer class, and emailed their sponsors for at least once a month, this has given us much better communication between students and sponsors. The form 3s will start their computer training as soon as they get back. We realize that Computer skills are absolute necessity no matter what the students do in future.

We have a cargo box full of used gym shoes that weighs 50 pounds and we will need \$200 to ship it with the next person that comes from America. Because of Covid there are no mission team planned at this time. Planned projects, the new grad dorm and the front gate, and cementing the floors in all the dorms have been put on hold.

Next year the Government says that we will need to add P7 and P8, two more grades. If that really happens we will need to buy land, build 4 new dorms for girls and boys and build two new classrooms. We are not getting too worried about it because the Government changes their minds for at least once a week. At least once a week we have black out and no electricity which means no water. Sometimes it last for an hour and sometimes a whole week. It's frustrating. We would like to explore the possibility of putting solar power at least in the Dining Hall so the kids can study. Please keep all these things in your prayers.

An anonymous donor has come forth and is willing to sponsor with a matching grant for the form one students of this past year who have not gotten a sponsor.

Fifteen Form 1 students at Living Hope have been waiting patiently for a sponsor. They need sponsors so they can continue to work towards their high school education. Until July 1, thanks to a matching grant, you can sponsor a student for \$55 a month – about the value of two bags of groceries.
